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Comparison of CAD software History In 1990, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD, a vector graphics application for the Macintosh with a number of additional features. AutoCAD was one of the first such software packages for the Macintosh (and the first Autodesk product for the Macintosh platform). It was preceded by other Mac applications, including an early CAD system from Corel, and a vector graphics system from a company named TRC. The original version of AutoCAD for the Macintosh was known as the "AutoCAD LT" and was never released to the general

public. AutoCAD 1 was the first version to support Windows. AutoCAD 2 was the first version released under the "Autodesk" label. AutoCAD LT was released for the Mac in 1994. The Mac version had a number of significant limitations compared to the Windows version. The Mac version was eventually released in 1995 under the name "AutoCAD".
