The main adjustment layer is used to filter the image, change the background, and even change the color of your image. In this book you will use adjustment layers primarily to make small changes to color, toning, exposure, contrast, and saturation. When you add an Adjustment Layer, you can see an icon next to it indicating what the layer will do, as shown in Figure 4.1A. You have many options for saving files using Photoshop's File menu, including saving JPEG, TIFF, PSD, and JPEG 2000 files (for examples, see File Menu). However, using the Layers panel provides a special and very powerful option: saving layers.
